




UC SHIP has an app!

Your UC SHIP plan is just one tap away with the new StudentHealth app from Anthem Blue Cross (Anthem). Use it to quickly and easily access:

- Your member ID card
- Campus student health services information
- A description of your UC SHIP plan benefits
- Anthem for medical claims and other plan details
- Health tips tailored to your individual needs



You can also access myCatamaranRx and Delta Dental, too. You'll need to register and log in to each plan to find your ID cards, plan benefits information and more.

Get StudentHealth

From your smartphone or tablet, select a button and then download the app.



From your computer, visit www.mobilehealthconsumer.com/studenthealth.

Now, Register!

Once it's on your device, tap *Register Now* and follow these three simple steps:

1. Enter your first name, last name, student ID number and date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy); then go to the next screen.
2. On the *Credentials* screen, select a username—typically **firstname.lastname**—or use the one assigned to you.
3. Create a password containing at least six characters, including a letter and number.

Trouble registering? Adjusting your input in the “first name” field should access the site:

- First name [space] middle name (ex. Joseph Jayden)
- First name [space] middle initial (ex. Joseph J)
- First name [space] middle initial with a period (ex. Joseph J.)

That's it. You can now log in to StudentHealth with your username and password!

About the New Student Health Mobile App

You're all about using your smartphone or tablet to get what you need — and fast! So, what if you could use these same devices to get info on your UC SHIP plan?

Beginning in August 2015, you can!

The new StudentHealth app — from Anthem Blue Cross (Anthem) — can help you quickly access UC SHIP information, including:

- Your member ID card (*printed cards are so last year*)
- Where to find student health services on campus
- What's covered under UC SHIP
- Your Delta Dental plan benefits

With StudentHealth, you can also connect with Anthem for medical claims and other plan details, and myCatamaranRx to get your ID card *and* manage prescriptions.

Plus, register with StudentHealth and you'll receive health tips just for you!

Go On, Get StudentHealth!

From your **smartphone** or **tablet**, download the app from the [Apple Store](#) or [Google play](#).

From a **computer** or **tablet**, visit www.mobilehealthconsumer.com/studenthealth.

Now, Register!

Launch StudentHealth, select *Register Now* and follow these three simple steps:

1. Enter your first and last name, student ID number and date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy); then go to the next screen.

Registration Tip

Trouble registering? Adjusting your input in the “first name” field should access the site:

2. On *Credentials*, note your new username — “firstname.lastname.”
 3. Create a password containing at least six characters, including a letter and number.

That's it! You can start using the app by logging in to StudentHealth with your username and password.

The Student Health app is only available to UC Irvine Graduate students who are enrolled in the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP).

UCSHIP StudentHealth App FAQs

What is the StudentHealth app?

StudentHealth is an app that allows UC SHIP members and their dependents to access plan ID cards and benefits information from their mobile devices.

Anthem Blue Cross and UC SHIP collaborated with Mobile Health Consumer to introduce this new app for the 2015/2016 plan year.

Why do I need the StudentHealth app?

Downloading and using StudentHealth is not mandatory – the choice is yours. It is important to note however, that your member ID card is only available online – you will not receive your card through the mail.

When you visit Student Health Services on campus or need to get covered services at a doctor's office, Urgent Care Clinic, hospital, pharmacy, etc., you'll be asked to present your UC SHIP member ID card. It's accessible through the app. StudentHealth also provides helpful information resources for your university and the UC SHIP plan benefits.

What can I use the StudentHealth app to do?

Use your mobile device anywhere, anytime to:

- Present your Anthem ID card when you need care.
- Decide when you need a referral to a healthcare provider outside of student health, and link with your Student Health Services to obtain one.
- See what your plans cover and how much your share of costs will be, if any.
- Find out how close you are to meeting your out-of-pocket maximums for the year.

OBTAINING THE APP

How can I get the app?

Download the free StudentHealth app for Android devices from [Google Play](#) or for iOS devices from the [Apple Store](#). Search for the app name, StudentHealth.

What devices are supported?

On iOS devices version 7 or later. On Android devices version 3.0 or later.

What if I don't have a supported mobile device?

You can access the app from a web browser at www.mobilehealthconsumer.com/studenthealth

I downloaded the app, but cannot install it.

Verify that your device has enough space/memory by trying to download another app. If that fails too, clear cache, disk space and/or memory on your device. Restart your device. Make sure you are running a supported operating system on your device.

How do I change my StudentHealth username and password?

On the Navigation Menu, use the *Profile* link in the Settings Section.

How do I register?

Follow these steps to register:

- Click the *Register Now* link after downloading and opening the app.
- Enter your first and last name, student ID number and date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy); then go to the next screen.

Registration Tip

Trouble registering? Adjusting your input in the "first name" field should access the site:

- First name [space] middle name (ex. Joseph Jayden)
 - First name [space] middle initial (ex. Joseph J)
 - First name [space] middle initial with a period (ex. Joseph J.)
- Note the username at the top of the page. You can change it or leave it as it is.
 - Enter the Password and Confirm Password. Click *Next* button.
 - Confirmation alert gets displayed that you have successfully registered.
 - Log in to the app with your username and password.

USING YOUR ID CARD

Can my dependents see their ID cards in the app too?

You can send an email invitation to your dependents to register to use the StudentHealth app. Enter the dependent's email address and select the *Send Registration Email* button. When the dependent receives the email, he/she can click on the link in the email to complete the registration process. Or, a dependent can download the app and select the *Register Now* link. If using this method to register, the dependent will need to provide the benefits-enrolled student's ID number, along with the dependent's own name and date of birth.

How can I see my ID Cards in the app?

On the Navigation Menu, use the *ID Cards* link in the Benefits Section.

How can I see the details of my UC SHIP plan benefits in the app?

On the Navigation Menu, use the *Descriptions* link in the Benefits Section.

How do I find out about my out-of-pocket calculations?

To find your out-of-pocket calculations (or accumulations) for the compilation of your out-of-pocket expenditures, click the *Anthem* button from the home page or navigation and follow the links to log into [Anthem.com](https://www.anthem.com). Log in using your Anthem ID and password.

How can I print my ID card?

If your device has access to a printer, print the ID card the same way you would print anything else from your device. Otherwise, consult your device's user manual to take a screen image of the ID card and email it to a person or device who can print it. Or, access the app from a computer with printer access at www.mobilehealthconsumer.com/studenthealth.

Can Customer Support print my StudentHealth ID card?

No. Customer Support cannot see or print a StudentHealth ID card.

MAKING CHANGES**How do I change my password, username, or contact information?**

On the Navigation Menu, use the *Profile* link in the Settings Section.

How do I delete a message from the Notification Center?

Select the *Edit* button. A check box will appear next to every message. Choose the messages you want to delete. Press the *Delete* button. Once you delete a message, it is permanently gone.
